Qualifications:

- Appropriate university degree and teacher qualifications in Special Education with an emphasis on GATS/Enrichment/GLD (gifted underachievers)
- Knowledge of the teaching and learning process and study skills
- Respect and appreciation of young people and their learning needs
- Passion and ability to meet the needs of students who are gifted, learning disabled, behaviourally challenged or with Autism Spectrum Disorders
- Proven ability to work in a team, collaborating with staff and parents
- Up to date knowledge of incorporating technology into the curriculum

Duties:

- Da Vinci Program responsibilities
- Work with the Learning Support team to provide services to students either directly or through sharing strategies with subject teachers. There is a strong emphasis on the Case Management model with some “in class teacher/learner support” /shared teaching
- Responsibility for GLD students who require individual learning profiles
- Knowledge and application of testing for specific learning difficulties
- Working collaboratively with subject teachers to differentiate curriculum and assessment tasks. Provide innovative differentiated, needs based strategies in the areas of enrichment, study skills/organisation, social skills, boarder support
- Planning Individual Learning Programs for individual students involving the student, staff and parents
- Liaise with Specialists re students’ needs as they impact on the educational programme
- Co-curricular responsibility with the Da Vinci and or Future Problem Solving programs on campus and off campus in after school hours as required
- Form Mentor supporting the Positive Psychology Program
- Other duties as required
