



### **Fiji Scuba Diving Adventure - December 2007**

*During the recent summer vacation, seven Year 12 (2008) boys travelled to sunny Fiji for a relaxing week of scuba diving before Christmas. The tour party were accommodated at the very tropical and lush Seashell Cove Resort which was 45 minutes from Nadi Airport on Fiji's Coral Coast.*

*For each of the scheduled diving days the boys completed a double tank boat dive in the morning when the conditions were most favourable. The dive locations varied daily and included exploring coral reefs, gardens and swim-throughs, mysterious caves and also engaging with the local marine life. Sea snakes, moray eels, nurse sharks, white tipped reef sharks, anemone, numerous reef fish and corals were often sighted on most dives which were consistently 15-20 metres visibility.*

*Apart from the diving the tour party sampled the bustling Nadi (trading) town, authentic local cuisine, a real 'Batman' cave, the customs of local villages, a fishing trip, resort cats and 'Fiji time' at the resort. Highlights on the village tours included meeting the local chiefs and linking up with smiling local Fijian children for a fun game of volleyball. The adventure was a fun, educational South Pacific experience for the boys with fond memories that will no doubt last a life time.*
