



2018 PRIVATE MUSIC LESSONS

Private lessons on all orchestral and band instruments, voice, piano, guitar, bagpipes and musicianship are offered in the Prep School.

Lesson times are allocated in the fairest possible manner, on a rotating timetable (Rota). The Rota ensures lessons are given at a different half-hour each week, on the same day. Boys leave class for scheduled lessons. Lessons commence before school and include recess and lunch hour, minimising class clashes.

Students learning more than one instrument at Knox Grammar School may be considered for fixed lesson times, however, cannot have two lessons on the same day. Fixed times are only given with the consent of the Director of Instrumental Music.

The Fee Schedule is attached for your perusal. Lessons are payable directly to the Private Instrument Teacher upon receiving an invoice. Each term is made up of eight lessons. Prompt settlement would be appreciated and will avoid termination of tuition. Please make cheques payable to the teacher as detailed on the account.

Notice in writing to the Director of Instrumental Music (Miss Beck Morris) **four weeks before the end of a term**, is required to discontinue lessons; otherwise the next term's fees will be charged.

Lessons missed by teacher absence will be credited or made up. Lessons missed by students being absent will be forfeited unless **the Private Instrument Teacher receives PRIOR notice**.

In the case of illness, parents **phone the instrumental teacher** the day/evening prior to the lesson day. Teachers' contact numbers will be on timetables and in 'Music Exercise' books. In the case of sudden illness/non-availability, please phone the Private Instrument Teacher immediately.

The dates for all excursions, examinations and camps, which may clash with music lessons, are available on the portal. It is **the responsibility of the parent** to notify the Private Instrument Teachers to reschedule their lesson time.

Semester reports will be written on student progress and emailed to parents at the end of each semester.

PRIVATE MUSIC TUITION

Please note that Knox offers a hire agreement on a few specialised instruments, such as trumpet, euphonium, tenor saxophone, trombone, flute, violin, cello, double bass and tuba.

Many local music stores have hire/purchase facilities, which you are at liberty to compare. Comparisons should be between instruments of similar high quality.

The Prep School Music Department recommends a traditional approach to music lessons on all instruments. This involves an understanding of the rudiments of music and essential technique. Examinations are also recommended (not compulsory) providing a set of goals, a measure of progress, a source of both challenge and satisfaction and independent advice on progress and potential. AMEB and Trinity College syllabuses are available, as is advice on suitable grades. Students undertaking lessons in the contemporary genre may also undertake AMEB examinations as well as prepare for Instrumental concerts and other performances.
