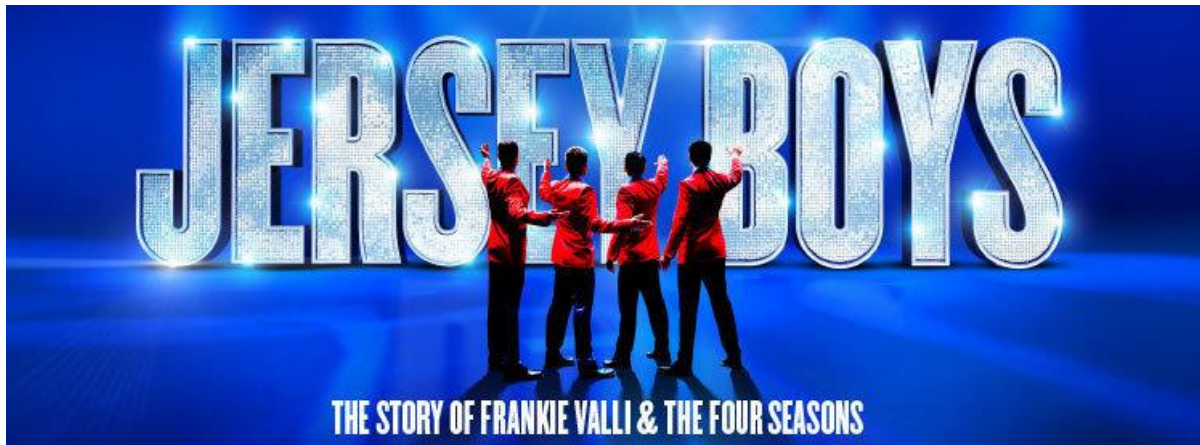

The band sold more than 175 million records and were inducted into the Rock 'n' Roll Hall of Fame for their worldwide hits, including *Can't Take My Eyes Off You*, *Walk Like a Man*, *Bye Bye Baby*, *Sherry* and *Big Girl's Don't Cry*, which all feature in the musical.
