## FROM THE HEADS OF STAGE 6 ACADEMY TEAM

It was nice to welcome the boys back on Thursday. The boys are to be congratulated on the way they approached their exams and we believe they learnt a lot about an external exam period.

As the post-exam period begins, some important information is contained below.

- It is essential attendance and punctuality at every class is without fault right through to the last day of term (Friday 28 September). The boys will be receiving their exams back and the feedback will inform the work that needs to be done over the break (feed forward). Gaps in knowledge and skills that the exams exposed must be addressed prior to next term as Year 11 work becomes assumed knowledge in Year 12.
- The boys commence as Year 12 on Day 1 next term. They will have an assessment period from about Week 5 onwards. Some subjects will have assessments in the final week of Term 4 so early leave prior to the summer vacation should be avoided. An assessment schedule for Term 4 will be distributed in Week 1 next term.
- Any boy who wants to amend their pattern of study to pick up an extension subject is to complete a change of subject form, have it signed by the relevant staff, obtain a parent signature and then return to Ms Hitchcock by Thursday 27 September.
- On Monday 29 October (Term 4 Week 3) all boys and parents are encouraged to attend an HSC information session starting at 7pm in Seniors' Hall. Please save the date for this important evening. Further details will be provided early next term.
- NESAs rules enable students to drop to 10 units in Year 12. There is no rush to drop a subject. We suggest students wait until after they have a Knox Academic Indicator (KAI) interview in Week 4 next term. Details of the KAI interviews will be provided at the information session on 29 October.
- Teachers are working on reports and they will be available online on Friday 28 September at approximately 3.30pm.

YEAR 11 PREFECT AND COLOURS AWARDS

Year 11 students will be able to submit their blazers for Prefect and Winter Colours for embroidery during the Term 3 holidays. A member of staff from the Uniform Shop will be in the WSA during the last week of Term 3 to confirm Prefect titles and Colours to be received from the latest list. All students must check the list which will be located on the outside of the WSA Admin office.

Each student submitting a blazer must do the following:-

- Complete the [attached form](#) and ensure it is signed by a parent
- The form is to be placed in the top pocket of the blazer when handed in.
- All badges and personal possessions are to be removed from the blazer pockets.
- The Blazer must be clearly named with a laundry marker so it can be identified.
- For Colours from previous years that have been not added, the student must supply the Uniform Shop with evidence of the award either by sight by a Uniform Shop staff member or copies of the certificate.
- A rail will be located in the WSA on the last two days of term to drop off the blazers.
- If you have any queries regarding the embroidery, please speak to a member of staff from the Uniform Shop.

Blazers received without the completed paperwork cannot be embroidered. Student Blazers can be handed in on the last day of attendance prior to the holidays and the deadline for handing in is 5pm Friday 28 September.

The Blazers will be available for collection from the Uniform Shop from 8am on Tuesday 16 October.

If this deadline is missed the next opportunity to get embroidery done will be the end of Term 1, 2019.
