CHRISTIAN VALUES TEACHER PREP SCHOOL (PART-TIME)

SCHOOL MISSION STATEMENT

Knox Grammar School seeks to be an exemplary school developing within a caring, Christian environment, young people of integrity, wisdom, compassion and faith; students with a sure knowledge of who they are and how they should live.

ROLE PURPOSE

The Prep School Values Teacher will be appointed to the School to join the School's Chaplaincy team, which currently is the two School Chaplains. This person will assist this team and the Wisdom, Life, Faith Department to educate and minister to the spiritual welfare of our students in a dynamic growing school community based on the Total Fitness Model.

This role works as part of the School's support team and the broader School Community, which is inspired at all times by the highest ideals of collaboration, co-operation, integrity and team-work.

The Christian Values Teacher will teach 8 classes per week.

ROLE RESPONSIBILITY

The Christian Values Teacher will report directly to the Head of Prep who delegates specific duties and responsibilities and work with the WLF department of Knox. As with all School employees the Christian Values Teacher is ultimately responsible to the Headmaster.

ROLE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- The Christian Values Teacher will teach classes to Years 5 and 6 at the Knox Preparatory (KPS) Campus.
 - They will work alongside the School Chaplains in offering spiritual care to the Knox community.
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Positive Education and Wellbeing

- The Christian Values Teacher will work with the Total Fitness Teams within the Preparatory School.

SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

Teamwork

- The appointed Christian Values Teacher must be able to work effectively in a team. He/she will work with our School Chaplains and WLF Department as part of a collaborative and supportive team.

Excellent communication skills

- The Christian Values Teacher must be articulate, have a creative approach and be inclusive.
- Skills in presenting creative liturgy and music are important.
- A friendly and responsive approach to ministry and social interactions is vital in this role.

QUALIFICATIONS

This is a position for a fully accredited school teacher.

Understanding, and a willingness to work within, the ethos of the Uniting Church in Australia is required.

The Christian Values Teacher will actively support and contribute to the maintenance and development of a safe working environment by:
